New-look Zones



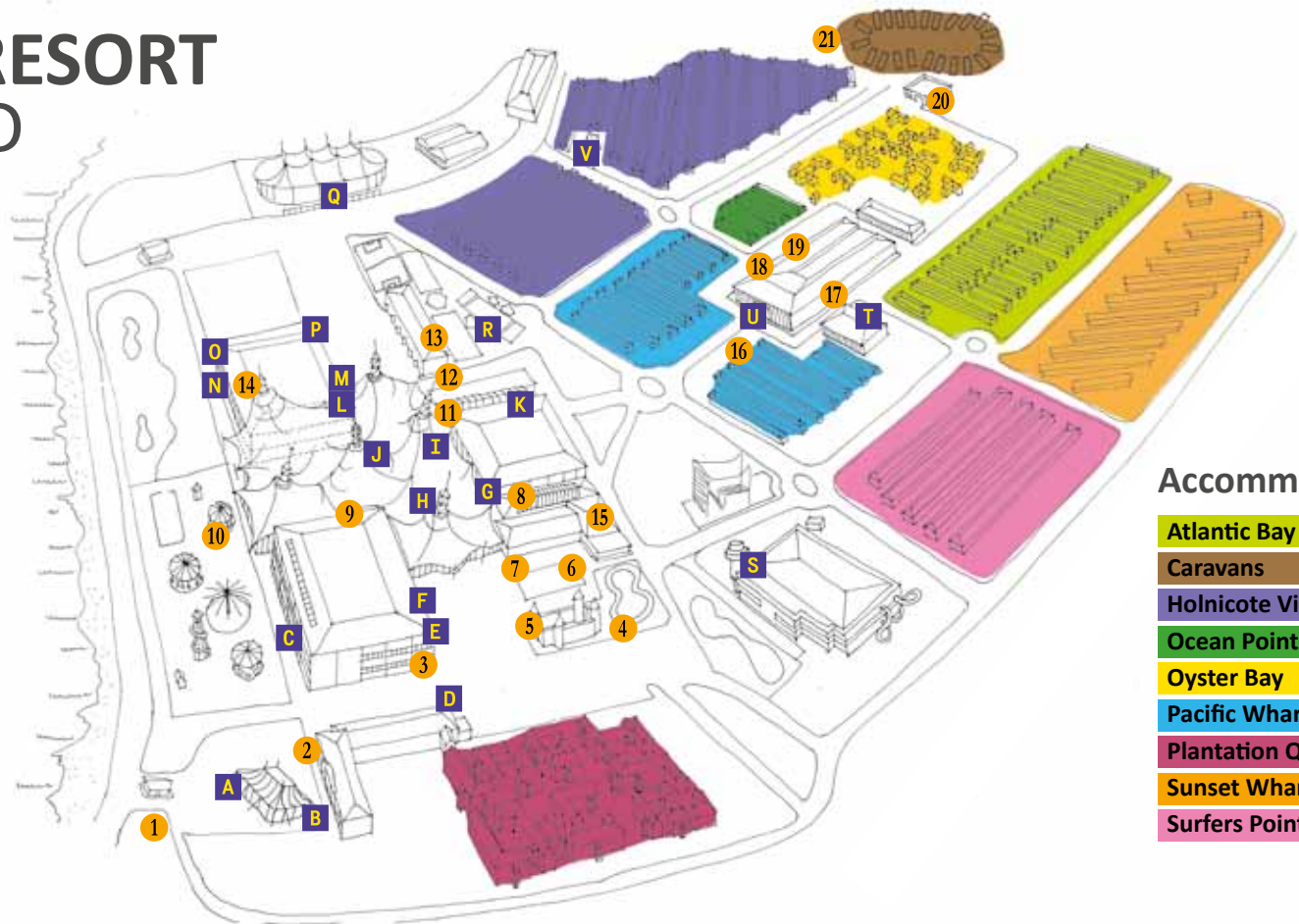
