We aim to make as much of the Spring Harvest programme as possible, as accessible as we can.

Programmes for kids, youth and young adults have areas where those with additional needs can find team members to support them in accessing the programme in a way that suits them.

Count Everyone In run some sessions for adults with learning disabilities on both resorts.

We have a Disability Consultant on each resort to help you find what you need. All venues offer hearing loops and wheelchair access, some also offer speech-to-text translation, BSL interpretation and sensory profiles. On request, we can also provide large print and braille resources.

The Everyone In Fund

We don't want affordability to be a barrier to experiencing a life-changing week at Spring Harvest. Those who qualify for Government benefits can apply for automatic discounts, and we can also offer more help to those that need it, until all the money is allocated.

We are usually able to help more than 600 people a year to attend with various amounts, thanks to the generosity of others. If you want to explore this via an online application, you will need a Church leader, a group organiser or someone willing to give you a reference. **We'd love to help.**

This fund also helps us livestream directly into prison cells and into people's homes, for all those who can't make it in person.

Accommodation


